

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

JULY 7, 2015

Board Members Present: President Marty Rubin; Secretary Wendy Soares; Treasurer Nancee George; Social Lynn Fraser; Publicity Cindy Pulliam; Membership Katie Bloom; Training Cal Meissen and Tournament Rein Lemberg.

Approval of June Minutes: Moved by Nancee George, seconded by Rein Lemberg. Minutes approved.

Quorum: Quorum established.

Presidents Report: Marty Rubin reported that our proposal for four additional pickleball courts was turned down by the City of Lincoln. This was because we could not eliminate one of the entrance/exits because emergence vehicles would have difficulty accessing the sports area.

Secondly, there have been a number of complaints about the advertising that has been hung up on the fences around the pickleball courts. We are trying to get them removed and put into a case in the sports pavilion.

At the next **Association Properties Meeting, this Tuesday, July 14th at 1:00 P.M., in Orchard Creek Lodge.** Marty will be making another presentation for additional pickleball courts. The Board would appreciate if as many pickleball members show up as possible to show your support in increasing the number of pickle ball courts.

Board Reports:

Membership: Katie Bloom reported we now have 444 paid club members with 86 new members. Katie reminded people that we really need to make our new members feel welcome. Social: Lynn Fraser reported that 125 members have signed up for the Summer Party, there are two and a half weeks left to get your reservations in. Bring something to

share. It is not a full dinner, just bring snacks or fruit or cookies. Next weeks Wednesday Mixer (so long as it isn't too hot), will be the 3.5 and above level players. There will be a "Dinking" Competition with prizes. We will not be playing rally games.

PUBLICITY: Cindy Pulliam said that she is open to suggestions for topics for articles that she can write up for the Compass or the Sun City News . Committee Reports:

Ladder: Mike Hilton had no report.

Tournament: Rein Lemberg reported the Rookies Invitational Event, for beginner and "D" level players, has 34 women and 12 men signed up. The women will be playing on Saturday, August 1st and the men will play on Saturday, August 15th. Rein plans to have a blind draw for the women, after ladder play on July 22nd. Rein had to change the format for The President's Cup, being held August 4, 5 & 6th. It will now be a Round Robin format similar to the Super Senior Tournament.

Registration for the Wells Fargo Tournament will be held in August after the Presidents Cup Tournament.

Charities: No Report.

Beginner Training: Cal Meissen reported less attendees, likely due to the heat. **Classes are held at 12:00 p.m. beginning June 1st.**

P.B. 101 Training: Andrea Mayorga reported classes are going well. The latest orientation class did not have anyone attend. The drill with the Simon Machine is going very well. Everything is set up through the end of August at this time.

If the funds are not available, then the repair of lighting will be in next year’s budget for the work to be done.
